

*1, The Square - Bijou garden with wonderful scents.
Telephone Box Border - Plus artwork of local landmarks from Shere Infant School

Ulus - Cottage garden full of flowers.

Vine Cottage - One of Shere's oldest dwellings, this simple village garden allows a rarely seen view of the 14th century facade.

*Workshop Cottage - An old cottage garden built in terraces up a hill. Entry to the garden is up steep steps so this garden is not suitable for all visitors

Slightly Further to Walk

*The Old Netley Mill ('Shere Mill') - Landscaped gardens with lake and islands around historic water mill on river Tillingbourne.

Netley Mill House - Stunning, landscaped water garden around former mill owner's house.

Directions: continue from school past surgery, for further 5 minutes Both gateways adjacent, off A25 Disabled parking at Old Netley Mill

Drive to

Cariad, Hook Lane - Quintessentially English cottage garden with outstanding views and roses. One acre plot. Worth the detour!

Parking at Shere Court opposite Cariad.

Directions: drive out of the village up Shere Lane, passing both pubs on the right After half a mile, just over the railway bridge, turn left onto Hook Lane. The garden /parking are a short distance from the junction. Parking on right

Village Centre Gardens (listed alphabetically)

The Allotments - Over the wall gardeners' question time, so pick up some top tips from our experts!

Bodryn - Private courtyard garden in the heart of the village.

1 Forrest Place - Vivacious planting at the front of the house.

The Gables - Sweet cottage garden with resident ducks!

Knavehurst - Rambling hillside cottage garden, with fruit trees, kitchen garden, chickens and fantastic views

*Lime Cottage - Secluded cottage garden with attractive water feature.

*The Lodge - A 3 acre garden of mixed woodland, sloping lawns and established borders, with a kitchen and cutting garden. Recent landscaping has created a sunken garden and perennial beds.

Mad Jak - Colourful collection of pots and planters. Shop open.

North Downs - Formal bedded garden with unique views of the North Downs.

*Rack Close - Family garden commanding beautiful views over the village.

Rectory - A project in progress for the new incumbents, and their rescued hens

St James' Church Flowers, and entertainment by the Youth Group.

*Sayers - A beautiful walled garden with stream frontage at rear

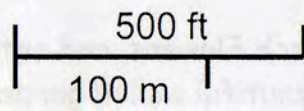

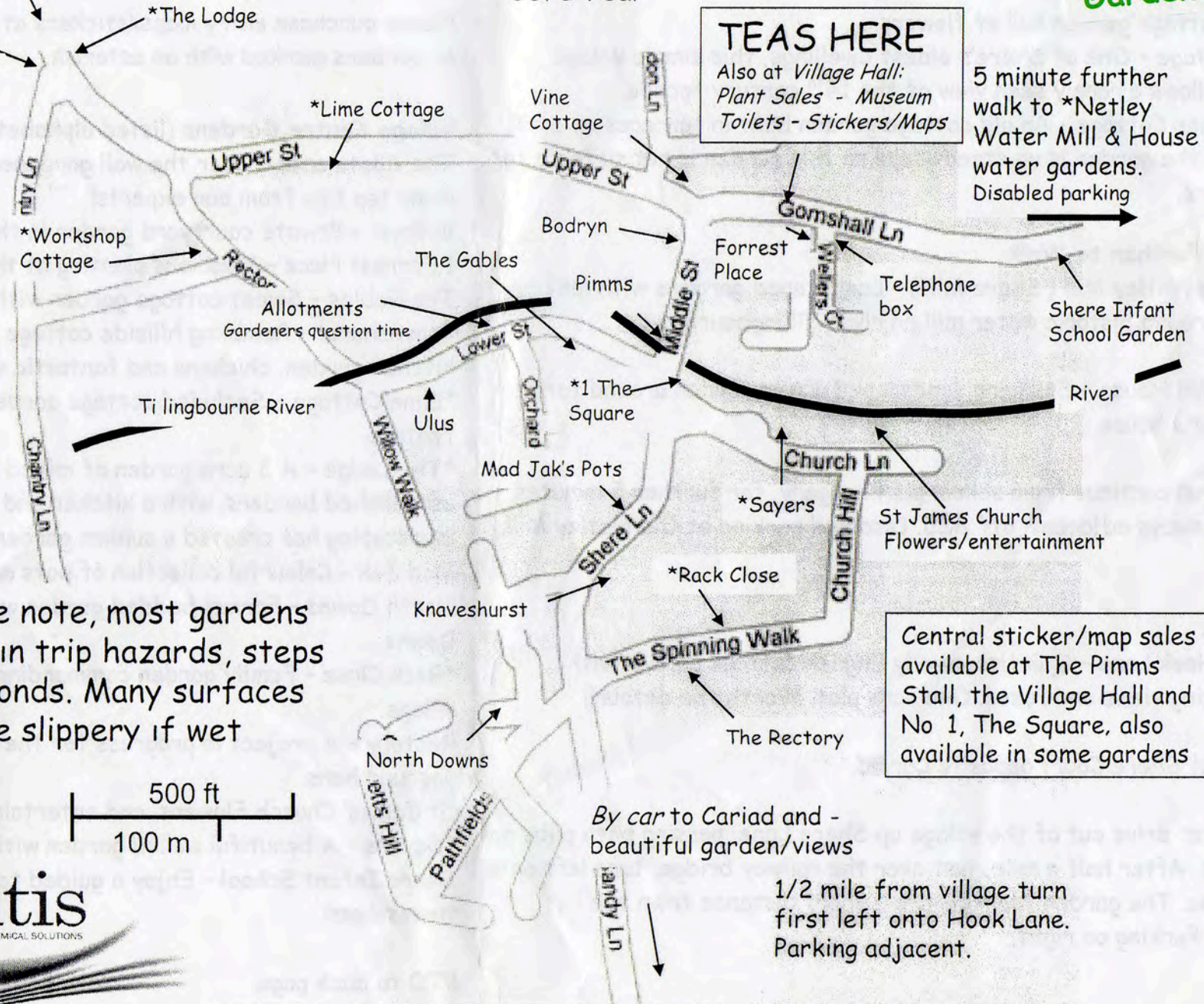
